[Kaposi's sarcoma](#) is a cancer of the skin and internal organs. It is named after the Hungarian dermatologist Moritz Kaposi (1837–1902), who first described it in 1872. Dr. Kaposi's last name was originally Kohn, but to distinguish himself from other physicians of the same name, he chose a new name in honor of the Kapos River, near his birthplace, Kaposvár, Hungary.
