in 2009 as COO. Worldview &#128522; Entertainment signed with Creative Artists

Agency (CAA) in 2010 and has since become the agency#39;s top film finance and

production &#128522; client. Sarah E. Johnson, daughter of Franklin Resources

Chairman, Charles B. Johnson, became a partner and investor in the company &#128

522; in 2011. Worldview established a four-yearR\$30 million credit facility with

Comerica in 2013 to provide debt financing for the company#39;s &#128522; films,

which coincided with the infusion ofR\$40 million in new equity from existing

investors. TheR\$70 million doubled the company#39;s capital &#128522; base.&lt;/p&gt;

which it financed along with Voltage Pictures in 2010. &#128522; The

domestically to LD Entertainment in one of the biggest sales at the festival. The
